ORDER

Subject: Constitution of an expert committee to examine and recommend changes / measures to simplify forms/format (to be filled up by the applicants) and reduce the in numbers.

It has been decided with the approval of the competent authority to constitute a Task force to carry out a comprehensive review of the existing processes / procedures / Forms / Licenses, etc. used by the Central Drugs Standards Control Organisation (CDSCO) and Laboratories under it, and to suggest change in the same with a view to simplify and make them user friendly as also shorten them. While reviewing the process/procedures/forms, etc., the Task Force will also keep in view the fact that these Processes/Procedures/Forms, etc. are eventually to be made compliant with the online system for development of which separate approval has already been accorded.

2. The composition of the Task Force will be as follows:

1. Dr. P. Jagashetty, Ex-Drugs Controller, Karnataka
2. Shri Uttarwar, Ex-Joint Commissioner, FDA, Maharashtra
3. Shri D.K. Shringi, Ex-Drugs Controller, Rajasthan
4. Shri P.K., Jaggi, Ex-Deputy Drugs Controller, Delhi
5. Shri R. Chandrashekar, Deputy Drugs Controller, CDSCO, HQ as convener
6. Representative of respective Industry Associations (five)

3. The services of representatives of the Department of Legal Affairs and the Legislative Department nominated to the Committee to review Drug & Magic Remedies (Objectionable Advertisements) Act, 1954 may also be associated in the process on 'as required basis'.

4. The Task Force will accomplish its assigned job in a maximum period of two months from the date of its first meeting and the recommendations in respect of first five forms will be submitted to the Drugs Controller General (I) within a period of 15 days and next five forms within the next 15 days.

5. Copies of the order are being faxed to all Industry Associations with the request to nominate member(s) and also urgently forward the suggestions, if any, to Shri R

Chandrasekhar, Deputy Drugs Controller at his e-mail rcs.ddci@yahoo.in. The nomination of members should be made by or before 27/10/2014 positively. The suggestions to make changes will be received only up to 15-11-2014.

6. The member of the Task Force other than from the Government and Industry will be given a sitting fee, TA/DA and other logistic support from the budget of the Indian Pharmacopoeia Commission, Ghaziabad (U.P)
